COMPETITION**

**DEADLINE: APRIL 20, 2007**

Creative Writing Scholarships are open to current University of Louisville students, both undergraduate and graduate; the awards are made in varying amounts of tuition reimbursement. You do not have to be an English major to apply. Judges for the competition are the members of the English Department Creative Writing Committee.

Students who wish to apply should present a folder containing the following material:

- 1) A cover letter. The letter should give the student's name, address (including zip code), e-mail address, telephone number, social security number, date of birth, level in school, list of creative writing courses taken (if any) and the name of the instructor/s. It should also state whether the student has in or out-of-state residence.
- 2) A sample of writing. Please submit 1-2 short stories, or 5-10 poems or some combination. Drama and creative nonfiction are acceptable.
- 3) Letter of recommendation. Ask one of your instructors to write a letter commenting on your writing, and on your ability to take criticism and contribute to class discussion.
